Assignments and Achievements

Been responsible for preparation for, and representation in, numerous construction adjudications in both a referring and responding capacity.

Retained by clients to advise on administration of various contracts including JCT, NEC and bespoke forms.

Retained by a client to act in capacity of "Commercial Director" on a particularly problematic project.

Seconded to a process engineering project on Humberside to resolve numerous quantum disputes between the purchaser and the civil engineering contractor (approx value in dispute £4m), and thereafter to administer the contract.

Advising a contractor on strategy and managing the process of successive adjudications regarding disputes with an employer concerning the termination of the contractor's employment under a JCT contract for the extension and refurbishment of a local authority leisure center, and the consequences thereof.

Acting as expert in determining a dispute between a contractor and employer as to the value of a final account for a project. This was achieved by the parties' jointly appointing and their agreement to be finally bound by the expert determination.

Management of forensic programming analysis to establish the cause of delay to the construction of a shopping center and the subsequent claim preparation against the architect and the steelwork contractor.

Preparation of a time and quantum claim against a structural engineer where errors in the design of a lecture hall building at a university led to delays to the construction programme. Liability had been admitted by the structural engineer but the effects of the errors remained in dispute. Adjudication proceedings commenced but part way through the process a settlement was achieved following a without prejudice meeting.

Successful defence of quantum and time claims brought against a contractor by an M&E sub-contractor in adjudications both on an interim application for payment and the final account.

Appointed as Quantum Expert in final determination disputes at both litigation and arbitration.

Presentations and workshops for contractors on commercial matters such as rights and obligations under HGCRA 1996, as amended by LDEDCA 2009.

Participation in "Mock Adjudication" presentations to various bodies including R.I.C.S. and C.I.O.B.

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
